

INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATE

Note:

1. Rs.500/- will be charged for not bringing the Hall Ticket to the Examination Hall
2. As soon as candidates have finished writing their answer and wish to give the answer books or at the end of the period prescribed for the particular examination each should stand up and remain standing until one of the superintendents has gone up to the candidate and received the answer book from the candidate.
3. Candidate must satisfy the chief Superintendent as to their identity. The certificates of Identity taken by them must contain their signatures.
4. Any discrepancy in respect of names and initials should be immediately reported to the Chief Superintendent, who will bring the matter to the notice of the Dean Research Section.
5. Candidates should write on both sides of the answer paper and at least 20 lines in a page
6. Additional answer books must be sparingly used and will not be given solely as a matter of Course
7. All candidates can obtain their statement of marks from the Controller of Examinations only a fortnight after publication of the results.
8. The candidates should write only the register number given to them. Writing the register number of other students will be treated as malpractice by the students
9. Students found in possession of incriminating material related to the subject of the Examination concerned or found copying from neighbor or inter-changing of answer Scripts will result in the cancellation of all papers written in the semester.
10. Candidates should write their Register No. only in the First Page of the Answer book.
