As a part of MoU, An International Webinar on “Generative AI for Effective and Responsible Research” was organized by Tamil Nadu Common Wealth Mother Teresa Women’s International Centre and Department of English and foreign Languages on 31/07/2025. The aim of the webinar was to educate and engage researchers, academicians, and students on the evolving role of Generative Artificial Intelligence (AI) in academic research, with special focus on its ethical and responsible usage. The program began with a warm Welcome Address delivered by Dr. A. Muthu Meena Losini, Assistant Professor of English who greeted the dignitaries, resource persons, and participants. The Presidential Address was delivered by Dr. K. Kala, The Honourable Vice-Chancellor. The speech emphasized the importance of adapting to technological advances like AI. The Inaugural Address was delivered by Dr. P. Jeyappriya, Registrar. In this address, she provided an insightful overview of Generative AI and its impact on research practices, including writing, data analysis, and content generation. The core session was led by the Resource Person, Dr. M. Selvakumar Samuel, Associate Professor, Asian Pacific University of Technology, Malaysia. The speaker explained the difference between projects and research, difference between dissertation and thesis. He highlighted the over-dependence on internet sources by PhD scholars. The session also explored AI vs real intelligence, A comparison between Eliza and ChatGPT showed how AI has evolved in communication. He concluded by reminding that only 4% of global data is publicly accessible online, urging researchers to use AI ethically and responsibly. The session was insightful and informative to all the researchers, academicians, and students. As the session came to an end, an interactive question and answer session was conducted, where participants raised insightful queries related to the ethical use of AI, issues of plagiarism, research gap and the scope and limitations of AI tools like ChatGPT in academic research. The resource person addressed each question with clarity and depth. The session concluded with a heartfelt vote of thanks delivered by Ms. A. Sajeetha, Research Scholar who expressed gratitude to the resource person for the enlightening presentation and to all participants for their active involvement, with that the Webinar ended successfully.
